Connecting Local Services

Chicago

Chicago Transit Authority (CTA): local bus and “L” service through downtown Chicago and surrounding communities. Day passes can be purchased for \$5. St. Louis

Metro: local bus and light rail service to downtown St. Louis attractions, western St. Louis suburbs, and East St. Louis and Belleville, Illinois. Day passes are \$5. For information call (314) 982-1400 or visit www.metrostlouis.org.

Dallas–Fort Worth Metro Area


