#### Service between Chicago and San Antonio

The Texas Eagle serves all stations between Chicago and San Antonio daily. Through service west of San Antonio operates tri-weekly, departing Chicago, Poplar Bluff and intermediate stations on Sundays, Tuesdays and Fridays. Eastbound trains departing Los Angeles on Sunday, Wednesday and Friday arrive stations San Antonio–Little Rock on Tuesday, Friday and Sunday, and stations Walnut Ridge–Chicago on Wednesday, Saturday and Monday.

### Service on the Texas Eagle®

- **R** Coaches: Reservations required.
- Sleeping cars: Reservations required. Superliner sleeping accommodations. Amtrak Metropolitan Lounge available in Chicago and Los Angeles, and a private waiting area available in St. Louis for Sleeping car passengers.
- Dining: At-seat Flexible Dining meal service between Chicago and San Antonio, and full meal service between San Antonio and Los Angeles, provided complimentary for passengers holding sleeping car accommodations. Traditional meal service currently suspended for coach passengers.



### **Connecting Local Services**

#### Chicago

Chicago Transit Authority (CTA): local bus and "L" service through downtown Chicago and surrounding communities. Day passes can be purchased for \$5. #### Dallas-Fort Worth Metro Area
